

CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. The Municipality of Greenstone Recreation Department is committed to providing a sport environment in which all individuals are treated with respect. The recreation facilities are to be enjoyed by all the residents of the Municipality of Greenstone and visitors. The use of the recreation facilities is a privilege and not a right.
- 2. During the course of all Municipality of Greenstone activities, athletes, coaches, parents, directors, volunteers, staff, chaperones and others shall:
 - a) Conduct themselves, at all times, in a fair and responsible manner and refrain from comments or behaviors that are disrespectful, offensive, abusive, racist or sexist. In particular, the Municipality of Greenstone **will not** tolerate behavior that constitutes harassment, abuse or bullying, and;
 - b) Avoid behavior which brings the Municipality of Greenstone or the sport/activity into disrepute, including but not limited to the use of alcohol in non-designated areas and/or non-medicinal use of drugs, and;
 - c) Nor shall they engage in activity or behavior that endangers the safety of others, and;
 - d) At all times adhere to the Municipality of Greenstone operational policies, procedures, and any rules governing any competition in which they are participating on behalf of the Municipality.
- 3. Failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to, the loss or suspension of certain or all privileges or activities connected with the Municipality of Greenstone. Such discipline may include the removal or ban from all arena and other facilities engaged in recreational activities sponsored by the Municipality of Greenstone.
- 4. The Municipality of Greenstone has a zero-tolerance policy regarding the use of alcohol in non-designated areas. <u>Alcoholic beverages are only permitted in the licensed areas and must not be served to minors. Alcoholic beverages are not permitted in the dressing rooms</u>. Any alcoholic infractions will result in a one-week suspension from all Municipal facilities. Any second infraction will result in an automatic suspension from organized activities held in Municipal facilities for a period of one year from the date of the infraction. In any circumstances that are deemed to be a reportable offense the Police will be notified and requested to assist.
