

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF GREENSTONE

BY-LAW 22-09

Being a By-law to set the operating and capital budgets for the rate supported environmental services for the Corporation of the Municipality of Greenstone

WHEREAS Section 289 of the *Municipal Act*, 2001, c.25 as amended (the “Act”) requires that a municipality prepare and adopt a budget including estimates of all sums required during the year;

AND WHEREAS Section 391 of the *Act* provides that a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it; for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board; and for the use of its property including property under its control;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality of Greenstone deems it necessary and expedient to pass a by-law to establish a rate supported operating and capital budget for the provision of environmental services including drinking water, wastewater, storm sewers and sludge management.


NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Greenstone **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **THAT** Council approves Water Systems operating expenses for 2022 of \$1,698,163 and capital expenditures of \$893,678 that includes \$172,790 for debt repayment and \$720,888 for capital projects that does not include carryover project amounts; and
2. **THAT** Council approves Wastewater/Sewer Systems operating expenditures of \$1,150,232 and capital expenditures of \$1,723,824 that includes \$836,966 for debt repayment and \$886,858 for capital projects; and
3. **THAT** Council approves a contribution to the rate supported budget from the tax levy supported operating budget of \$714,733 representing the projected shortfall for rate supported funding for 2022.
