COVID Prevention Responsibilities – Players and Parents / Guardians

- Please wash your hands with soap and water (or hand sanitizer) before and after gameplay.
- Carry hand sanitizer in order to enable good personal hygiene.
- Do not spit at any time.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose or mouth.
- Clearly label your own water bottle. Do not share bottles.
- Cover mouth and nose with a tissue or your elbow (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze.
- Ensure child is healthy and has no sign of COVID-19 symptoms.
- All participants must maintain 2m of socially distanced space when not on the field.
- Parents/guardians to keep a reasonable distance from the field, and social distance from other parents/spectators.
- Snacks should be discouraged, however if allowed, ensure they are consumed and/or disposed of on site and not taken home.
- Arrive 5 minutes before the end of any activity so that players can leave immediately after training rather than congregating around the field/exit.

COVID Prevention Responsibilities - Coaches Volunteers

- Must wear a mask on the field when unable to social distance.
- Try to avoid ball sharing during skilled drills.
- Coaches should wipe down personal and field equipment using the disinfected swabs or towels, before and immediately after each session (do not go home and then clean – contaminated items may travel into the home environment).
- Only Coaches/Volunteers should handle equipment.
- Structure activities to maximize physical distancing.
- Regular sanitization breaks combined with water breaks.
- Use cones and other equipment to ensure appropriate spacing is in place to support distancing.

We understand that the COVID-19 environment can be challenging or unpredictable. We will do our due diligence to provide safe programs and strict protocols, but if individuals feel uncomfortable or unsafe in the current climate - we respect and understand any player's choice not to participate at this time.
