



COMMUNITY CLEAN-UP SAFETY TIPS!

Please review the safety tips below and remember to put safety first!

- ⇒ Use personal protective equipment (gloves) or a litter grabber when picking up litter.
- ⇒ Clean-ups should take place during daylight hours.
- ⇒ Be mindful of slippery or unstable ground.
- ⇒ If collecting litter along a roadway please wear brightly coloured clothing or a safety vest.
- ⇒ Do not pick up dangerous materials such as glass, barbed wire, syringes/needles, medical waste, pipes, chemicals or debris with sharp or rusted edges. Instead, note down the item and the location, and contact the Municipality at 807-854-1100.
- ⇒ Avoid water filled areas such as ditches, streams, or ponds.
- ⇒ Be careful of wild animals, insects, hives and nests, and noxious weeds.
- ⇒ Report suspicious items to the Ontario Provincial Police via their non-emergency telephone number 1-888-310-1122.
