## APPENDIX 'A' - Medical Self-Declaration

STUDENT CADET POSITION PROFILE

**TASKS INCLUDE:** carrying heavy equipment such as ladders, chain saws, fire hose, hydraulic extrication tools, etc., lifting, pulling, chopping, climbing stairs/ladders, crawling, wearing self-contained breathing apparatus and other heavy personal protective equipment, performing cardio-pulmonary resuscitation.

**ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS INCLUDE**: possible exposure to toxic gases and particulates, chemicals, wet/damp conditions, exposure to extreme temperature variations for lengthy periods of time, required to perform tasks in confined working spaces.

**STRESSORS:** firefighting requires an individual to go from minimal physical activity to peak physical activity within a noticeably short time frame. Physical stress is amplified by the need to wear heavy personal protective equipment while carrying, pulling, pushing, lifting a variety of materials. The Student Cadet may also act in support of emergency operations where they may acquire knowledge of or be indirectly involved in traumatic emergency incidents.
